There were 18 participants: two representatives from each of Cal Poly’s nine sororities on campus. Presidents from the other IFC fraternities participated as judges and graded each contestant based on a variety of factors. First and Second place winners received custom belt buckles, and the

best combined team score earned bragging rights for a year as well as a barbecue hosted by the Brothers of AGR. This year Riley Horner was the overall winner and helped lead Sigma Kappa to the overall house title.

Brothers generate money to donate not only from the entrance fees of the contestants and tickets sale for the event, but we also solicit sponsorships from many local and family businesses. Proceeds increased over \$1,600 this year from the first year, and the chapter hopes to continue this trend at future events.
